NEW! SKATE CANADA HELMET POLICY: All Skate Canada member clubs and skating schools who offer a CanSkate program must ensure all CanSkate participants up to and including Stage 5 must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice. (This includes the lower group in Bronze Academy.)

A bike helmet or a ski helmet is not a CSA approved hockey helmet. It is very important that your club follow this policy as your insurance could be considered null and void if any injury occurs to a CanSkate participant not wearing an approved helmet.
